# Key results and outcome of the initiation of the pilot work including pilot courses (WP 06)

## WP 06: upstart pilot work, June – Dec 2016

- August 2016: an invitation to cooperation within the LEVER project published (Ngo.pl portal; ngo.pl newsletter; FAIEs webpage & FB; mailing to local and regional institutions and organisations);
- 5 applications received from interested organisations/informal groups from the South of Poland;
- 2 groups: one association and one informal group were invited to cooperation after preliminary dialogues via telephone/exchange of e-mails;
- 2 introductory meetings: 19-09-2016 (Czernica) and 30-11-2016 (Góra Ropczycka) took place

## Pilot courses (WP 06)

### 1) Training in Czernica, 19-11-2016

*„Planning, developing and relising projects by culture boosters”*

Training modules:

1. Project logics (planning, needs analysis, goals setting, activities planning, budget and schedule development, risks and results, monitoring, evaluation);
2. Business opportunities for NGO's;
3. Networking, clustering, partnerships building, local strategies building;
4. Team building and organizing team work;
5. Conducting marketing and promotional activities by NGO's;
6. Grants opportunities for co-financing the projects.

## Pilot courses (WP 06)

### **2) Webinar for the team from Góra Ropczycka, 15-12-2016** ***„Association or foundation?”***

Subjects:

1. The planned objectives and actions; organizational forms;
2. Association: types of associations, conditions of registration, registration documents;
3. Foundation: the conditions of establishing, registration documents;
4. The legal responsibilities, reporting and administrative provisions related to running an association;
5. The legal responsibilities, reporting and administrative provisions related to running a foundation;
6. Association's bodies and their role: general assembly, board, revision committee;
7. Foundation bodies and their role: founder, board, council;
8. The advantages and disadvantages of the association;
9. The advantages and disadvantages of the foundation.



## Plans for implementing the pilot work (WP 09)



## 1) „Spichlerz” Association

### **Celebrations of the 700th anniversary of the Czernica village**

- Start of planning: autumn 2016
- An idea: To celebrate together, inviting all interested to cooperation
- Activities: started in January; until now planned by September. Main events: May-August 2017 (The Czernicka Museums Night, the Historic Picnic and street run; LARP; micro-grants – local society ideas realisation)

- Main challenge: To reach outside region with information & promotion (short-term); to build widely recognisable local brand: „The Zamek” (long-term)

## 2) Góra Ropczycka informal group

### Local summer event

- Start of planning: winter 2016
- An asset: Buczyzna Park in Góra Ropczycka; access to potential sponsors;
- Ideas for activities: Light illuminations show/a concert/a cabaret/ an opera in the park/ thematic evenings (musical)
- Main challenge: To register a foundation and to organise 1st event (short-term); to create new sustainable workplace (long-term)

6. In what way the local society is involved in planning and preparing the activities?
7. At the moment: what is the main challenge? What causes troubles/is difficult?
8. At the moment: What goes better than supposed? What works best?
9. At the moment: What kind of support would be most useful for the realisation team (material/organisational/ at realisation/ at promotion/ other...)?
10. What is the next stage of works (next milestone)?
11. How are the activities financed/planned to be financed?
